

PRACTICES ABSOLUTELY NO PRACTICES AT OTSEGO PARK.

Once games begin use the following guidelines for practices...

If you have a game scheduled on Saturday you can use the same time slot on Sunday to practice as long as the game is played

If you do not have a game scheduled on Saturday you can practice on Saturday or Sunday at 9am or 7:30pm (first come first serve)

Mondays and Fridays are open dates for makeups. If you would like to practice on either day you must schedule with the league.

MAKEUPS

Any Saturday games on the following dates cancelled due to bad weather will be rescheduled for the next day (Sunday).

5/14, 5/22, 6/5, 6/12 cancellations rescheduled for 5/15, 5/23, 6/6, 6/13

Any games cancelled due to weather on any other Saturday or any weekday will be rescheduled by the league.

CANCELLATIONS

Coaches are NOT ALLOWED to cancel games on their own even if they call the opposing coach

Any game your team does not show up for will count as a forfeit

SCHEDULE

There are 5 teams in this division. Each team will be scheduled for 12 regular season games.

CHAMPIONSHIP

A one game championship game will take place between the 1st and 2nd place teams at the end of the season

This game is marked on the schedule but is subject to change

WEATHER

If the weather is questionable: coaches, players and parents can call the league mailbox to find out the status of a game

Please call (631) 586-1041 no more than 1 hour before game time. Listen for message. Do not leave a voice mail. You will not get a return call!

If there is no message regarding your specific game time on that date and you don't hear from your coach, you must show up at the rink where a decision will be made.

GAME RULES

It is the coaches responsibility to make sure all players receive fair playing time. This means every period of every game!

All games are played with (3) 15-minute stopped time periods (12 minutes for 7/8/9)

No Overtime. Tie is a Tie.

All games use delayed offside rules...

Ball must cross opponents blue line before players

If ball comes out of zone players may regain blueline as long as they do not touch the ball inside the zone

Icing from behind your own blue line will be called at ref's discretion (no icing in 7/8/9).

Each team is allowed (1) time-out per game.

Please treat the refs with respect.

If you have an issue with a call or something that occurs during a game you should calmly call the REF to your bench during a play stoppage to discuss

Please treat the refs with respect.

LIGHTS If the lights are not on, have the concession stand call Public Safety (422-7600) or call yourself and ask them to turn on the lights.

INJURIES If a player suffers an injury that requires medical attention, please ask for an Injury Report form at the concession stand.
